



*This Week in Review – March 17, 2023*

**Highlights from this week**

- **[Guarantee 2nd Amend Freedom and Protections](#)** was presented to the governor. It repeals pistol purchase permits.
- The **[Equality in Education](#)** bill was reported favorable and moved to the House rules committee. It prevents educators from teaching Critical Race Theory despite the fact that it is not being taught in schools.
- **[Two more bills](#)** to restore master’s pay supplements to teachers and instruction support staff were introduced.
